

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF HAZELBURY
BRYAN PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT ALEC'S FIELD PAVILION ON MONDAY 7th JANUARY 2019

01/19. Apologies for absence: Received from Jim Bettle (JB) and Mick Monaghan (MM)).

02/19. Declarations of Interest: None

05/19. To consider progress on development of the new community pavilion, including amongst other things a) painting: As advised by MW, the parish council has allocated £1,500 towards the final painting. AR hopes to arrange for this to be done with JB and Jamie Hart sometime in February **b) update on bookings, marketing etc:** AR has arranged an advert for the parish magazine. MW will see if there is room to include this in the next edition of Bryan Bytes. The very good news is that the Methodist youth club is starting in the pavilion from Friday 11th January 2019. There is a new local organiser, Deacon Rebekah-Joy Spinks, and if all goes well she will hold about 40 sessions during the year, from 7pm to 9pm on a Friday night. The success or otherwise will require some support and help from parents. JB and AR have suggested that if the club does get underway successfully the money held for "youth" activities could be used to provide some modern, hi-tec equipment - a large wall mounted screen for game playing for the kids, game consoles, Wii controller, music dock, projector etc etc. AR will explore and cost options. These facilities would also be available to other users of the pavilion. AR expects a representative from the club to attend the next Committee meeting, and potentially become a permanent member of the Committee. **c) "history" board:** JB is still working on this.
