

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF HAZELBURY
BRYAN PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT ALEC'S FIELD PAVILION ON MONDAY 12th FEBRUARY
2018 AT 6:30PM**

23/18. Apologies for absence: None received

24/18. Declarations of Interest: None

25/18. Minutes of the previous meeting: The minutes of the meeting held on 12th February 2018 were approved.

26/18. Matters arising: Covered in the agenda

27/18. To consider progress on development of the new community pavilion, including amongst other things a) snagging and further fitting out: Communications between Align and Snooks (and indeed the parish council) seem to have come to an end. Most of the snagging seems to have been completed bar the big sink in the kitchen which only has tepid water (a clear defect) and the water pooling in the shower. SM said that at the last site meeting he attended Snooks had agreed to provide a quote to re-configure the drainage arrangements. This has never been received. SM will contact Kevin Snook to try and move this forward. JB has wall painting and decorating volunteers lined up before the cricket season starts. He will also get a coy mat for the verandah. **b) update on bookings, marketing and formal opening date etc:** AR has bookings for two further parties, but it's slow progress. There is a calendar on the web site, but AR will add some further details to give more information. The Hedgehog Village group have an open day on 7th April, which might encourage people to come along and view what's on offer in the pavilion. The March/April edition of Bryan Bytes highlights the hiring potential on the front page. Discussions on a formal opening event looked at linking it to a village celebration for the Royal Wedding, maybe 19th May with a 2 pm start. SM agreed the parish council would consider this at its meeting on 9th April.

29/18. Annual play inspection report – review and action: In the absence of John Grayson this was held over until the next meeting.

30/18. Any other matters relating to the Recreation Ground: It was noted the hedge by the play area footpath had been cut back, presumably by the owner of the adjoining house.
