

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF HAZELBURY
BRYAN PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT ALEC'S FIELD PAVILION ON MONDAY 8th APRIL 2019 AT
6:30PM**

30/19. Apologies for absence: Received from Emma Grayson (EG) and Mick Monaghan (MM).

31/19. Declarations of Interest: None

32/19. Minutes of the previous meeting: Minutes of the meeting held on 11th March 2019 were approved.

33/19. Matters arising: These are covered in the agenda.

34/19. To consider progress on development of the new community pavilion, including amongst other things a) painting: Timing has slipped due to other commitments. AR will confirm the specification with Jamie Hart. The end of May is now a more realistic target date. **b) update on bookings, marketing etc:** AR said there are two weddings and the car rally in the diary. **c) "history of the development" - report update:** JB is working on this. **d) cricket and football club payments:** MW reported that the cricket payment for 2019 has been received, football payment for 2018/19 season due soon. **e) other pavilion matters:** AR is liaising with Alan Wilsden over the minor repair work agreed.

35/19. Youth Club and Wonston Club monies – progress and future plans: AR has identified a projector and screen and is arranging for an electrician to fit both. Apparently they can be powered off the lighting circuit. The projector will be Bluetooth compatible. RJS said the fun day arrangements are in place, although the bouncy castle was not now coming (but AR has some contacts that might be able to supply one). Hopefully the day might attract more regular attendees for the club. She will liaise with AR about extending the youth club's booking.

36/19. Football pitch improvements: JB reported that the work has largely been done by Jonnie Perrett and the costs might be much less than estimated.

37/19. Any other matters relating to the Recreation Ground: JB will ask Jonnie Perrett and Ernie Cluett to submit invoices for hedge and grass cutting. He will turn on the water for the allotments. The cricket club are having a memorial day for Gary "Fitzy" Fitzgerald and a memorial weather vane is being fixed to the pavilion roof.
