

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RECREATION GROUND COMMITTEE OF HAZELBURY
BRYAN PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT ALEC'S FIELD PAVILION ON MONDAY 20th MAY 2019 AT
6:30PM**

40/19. Apologies for absence: Received from Malcolm Wilson (MW).

41/19. Declarations of Interest: None

42/19. Minutes of the previous meeting: Minutes of the meeting held on 8th April 2019 were approved.

43/19. Matters arising: These are covered in the agenda.

44/19. To consider progress on development of the new community pavilion, including amongst other things a) painting: Jamie Hart has completed the painting on budget but one further days work is necessary for another coat of paint for the shower room walls, cost would be £200. Is the parish council happy to fund this? MW will raise at next parish council meeting. AR and RJS will be doing some gloss painting of the woodwork, JB will help if work commitments allow. Materials have been provided by Jamie Hart. **b) update on bookings, marketing etc:** Nothing particular to report **c) "history of the development" - report update:** JB produced a full-size version of his draft. This was unanimously approved and he will get help from Wessex Printing for the finished item. **d) cricket and football club payments:** Cricket for 2019 and football for 2018/19 have been received as agreed. **e) other pavilion matters:** Alan Wilsden is making good progress with shower bolt, pictures etc.

35/19. Youth Club and Wonston Club monies – progress and future plans: The electrical sockets for the projector and screen are in place. AR is having some difficulty sourcing a Bluetooth in projector with built-in speaker. RJS said the fun-day had been a great success although the enthusiasm hadn't followed through to the following weeks normal meeting. She remains positive about the future.

47/19. Any other matters relating to the Recreation Ground: JB has checked the water supply and meter readings and confirmed there is no leak. There is the possibility of a table-tennis club starting soon. HF reported on eight bookings for a toddler group and a junior youth club. Some hirers have said that blinds would be useful for privacy/films etc – might this come from the Wonston Club monies – to be considered?
